South East European University in Tetovo

The South East European University in Tetovo (SEEU), which has a branch in Skopje, is the biggest private public university of Macedonia and has the highest number of students. It is located in the north- western part of the country. The SEEU is specialized on social as well as economic sciences and is composed of three centers and of six following faculties: Business and Economics, Contemporary Social Sciences (Public Administration and Political Sciences), Law, Contemporary Sciences and Technologies (Computer Science) as well as Languages, Culture and Communication.

The SEEU is a member of the Balkan Universities Network and of the European University Association (EUA). The study programs of this university are offered in three languages: English, Macedonian and Albanian. In the national ranking the SEEU reached the second place among all the Macedonian Universities. Moreover, all of its study programs were confirmed by the Macedonian Office of Accreditation and Evaluation. The quality of the curricula is regularly proved by extern centers and international specialists. Another characteristic of this university is that it tries to develop the system of interactive studying in small groups.

Research

The SEEU established two main institutes for research in order to strengthen the multidisciplinary cooperation in the field of research. Furthermore, this university cooperates with following external partners: The Max Van der Stoel University for Research coordinates the most important political, legal and social scientific projects at the SEEU; The Institute for Ecology and Health is focused on subjects like ecological management and health prevention. Within these institutes, research groups of different domains work together in order to produce efficient results on an international level.
